QUALIFICATIONS

Members of the Board of Directors must be employed in the special events industry.

Directors should possess the ability to listen, analyze, think clearly and creatively, as well as work well with people individually and in a group. They should also possess honesty, sensitivity to and tolerance of differing views, a friendly, responsive, and patient approach, community-building skills, personal integrity, a developed sense of values, and concern for the SEARCH Foundation's development. Demonstrated skills in soliciting and disbursing funds, recruiting new board members and other volunteers, reading and understanding financial statements will also be welcomed.

EXPECTATIONS

Members of the SEARCH Board of Directors are required to attend Board meetings and teleconferences and may be asked to serve on a committee.

Regularly scheduled meetings are currently held in January (at TSE), May (teleconference), August (at ILEA Live) and November (in person, Los Angeles, Nov. 6-7, 2016).

SEARCH Board members are expected and mandated to personally "Give or Get" \$1,200.00 per year in donations to the Foundation.
